Study title: Psychological alienation in a light of some variables for juvenile delinquents: A study on a sample in Jeddah

The study aimed to identifying the differences in the total degree of psychological alienation among delinquent juveniles according to the following independent variables (age, type of violation, preparation of offense, housing).

The researcher conducted a survey method with a sample size of (74The researcher applied the psychological alienation scale that was developed by Samira Abker (1989).

The study,s results showed no statistically significant differences between the total score of the psychological alienation scale in the study sample and the age variable, The study also showed not statistical significant differences between , the total degree of psychological alienation in the sample and their type of violation. However, the results showed statistical significance between the total degree of psychological alienation and preparation of offense. Lastly, the results showed Statistical significance between the total degree of psychological alienation and the housing.

In accordance with these findings, a number of recommendations were made,

- Working to understand the feelings of the delinquent towards society, which helps the emergence of psychological alienation and treatment, to facilitate integration with the community.
- Allocate a full day of each month spent by the delinquent with his family as a reward to abide by the instructions, and family support for the next stage.

- The division of delinquent juveniles within the home into categories based on the type of offense, number of precedents, age group.
